myVTax Guide: How to Check the Status of a Return or a Refund

Without logging in, taxpayers may check the status of their Personal Income Return, refund, Homestead Declaration and Property Tax Adjustment, Renter Rebate status, estimated payments, and if they received a refund in the previous year, print their Form 1099G.

Step 1

From the **myVTax.vermont.gov** homepage, click **Check the Status of your Return** link in the **Returns** panel.



Step 2

You will be brought to a selection screen. Click on your choice. In this example, we are selecting **Personal Income Tax Return Status**.



Step 3

Enter in <u>all</u> required information.

- You will need to confirm that the ID you entered (ITIN or SSN) is correct.
- Enter your refund amount as it appears on your tax return.

Once all the fields are filled in, click the **Search** button.
