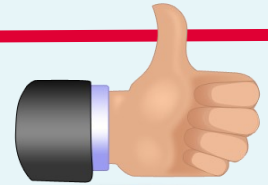

Identity Theft & Tax Refund Fraud

Follow These Rules of Thumb



DON'T give out personal info over the phone or email.



DON'T talk with a caller asking for your personal info. **HANG UP!**



DON'T open attachments in suspicious emails or click links. **DELETE THEM!**



DO respond immediately to a mailed notice from a federal or state tax agency telling you someone has filed in your name.



DO contact federal and state tax agencies and your tax preparer if you believe you have become a victim of identity theft or tax fraud.

NOTE: The Department of Taxes may communicate with taxpayers by email or telephone. If you are in doubt whether an email or phone call is genuine, call (802) 828-2865.
