32 V.S.A. § 3431. Lister's Oath

(a) Each lister shall take and subscribe and file in the town clerk's office, before entering upon the duties of his or her office, the following oath; and the oath as subscribed shall be recorded in the town clerk's office: [see above].

(b) When the listers violate such oath, they shall each be guilty of perjury and punished accordingly.
